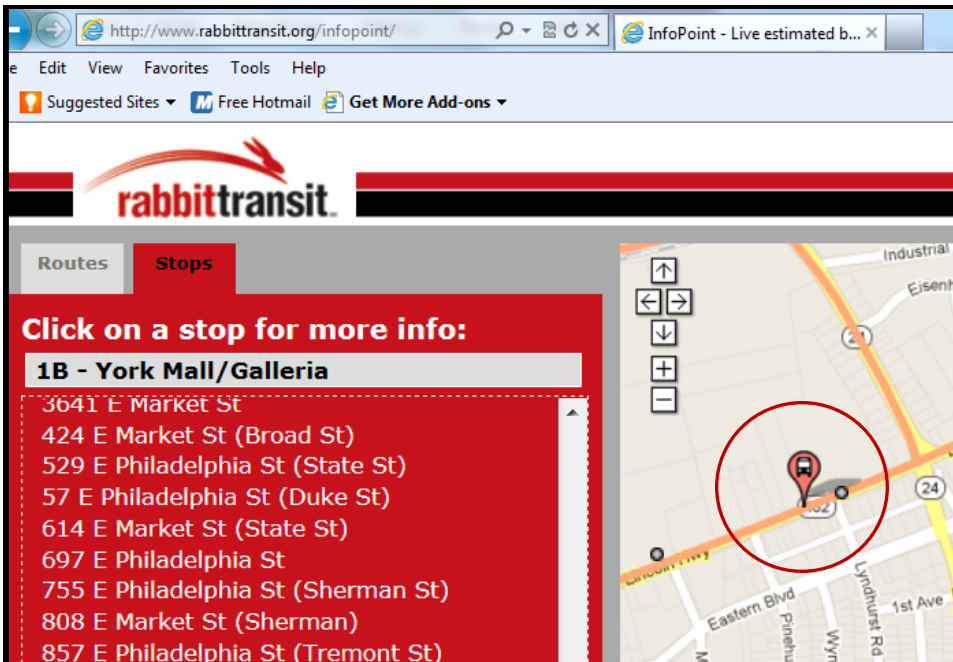


Commuter Tax Benefit Reduced

Congress failed to pass the extension of the \$230 level for the monthly transit commuter benefit before the December 31, 2011 deadline. The Transit benefit has now dropped to \$125 per month per person while the parking benefit has increased to \$240 per month. Public transit riders should tell Congress to support the commuter transit benefit as they resume negotiations to finalize the middle class payroll tax cut before it expires at the end of February. In addition, for the long-term, riders should encourage Congress to support Representative Jim McGovern's (D-MA) legislation in the U.S. House of Representatives and U.S. Senator Charles E. Schumer's (D-NY) legislation on the Senate side to permanently extend parity for this benefit.
